L'Odyssee is a medium sized school located in a fast-growing and multicultural urban centre. Moncton the only officially bilingual municipality in Canada, and as part of the Greater Moncton area (pop. 140 000 approx.), shares a public transit system with the cities of Dieppe and Riverview. A popular tourism and shopping destination, the area hosts international level concerts and shows from pop, rock, classical and ballet, as well as sporting events and festivals (literary, comedy, antique cars, etc.) Many kilometres of biking and walking trails are easily accessible and shared routes for cyclists and motorists are well signed. Twice a day the tides of the Bay of Fundy, the highest in the world, bring the *Tidal Bore*— an impressive wave running upstream against the current of the Petitcodiac River.
